NEWS FROM THE DEPUTY PRINCIPAL

This year we have lots of exciting events planned for our students to enrich their learning at school.

This term we have:

Aboriginal Art workshops for years 4-7, Swimming week for years R-5 (& IELC 6/7), , Choir for years 5-7 (over 100 students at the moment!) & Sports Day for the whole school on the last day of term.
