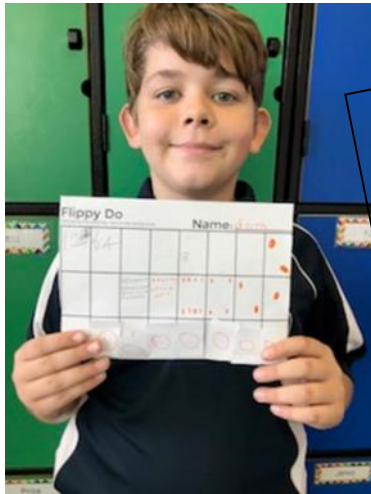
Digital Technologies in Focus Project
