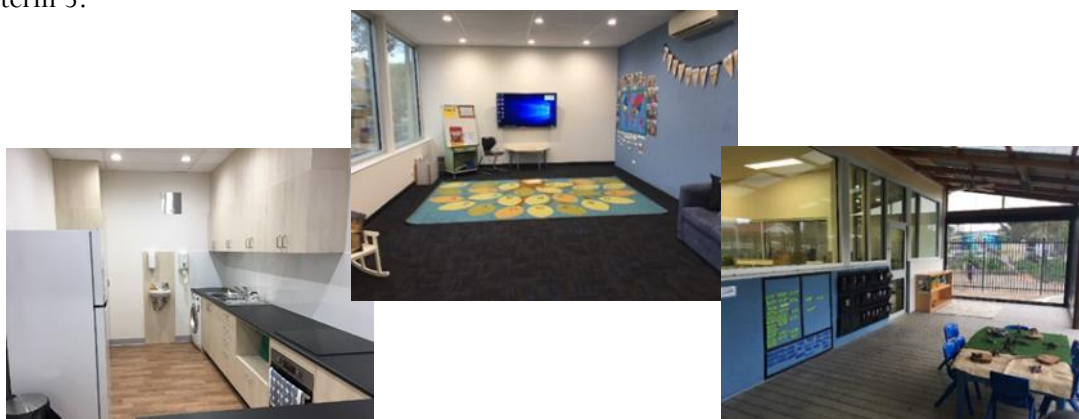
## NEWS FROM THE EARLY YEARS LEADER

The preference of our school is that orders and payments be made online, as this reduces the administration and associated security issues related to the return of cash & envelopes on photo day.

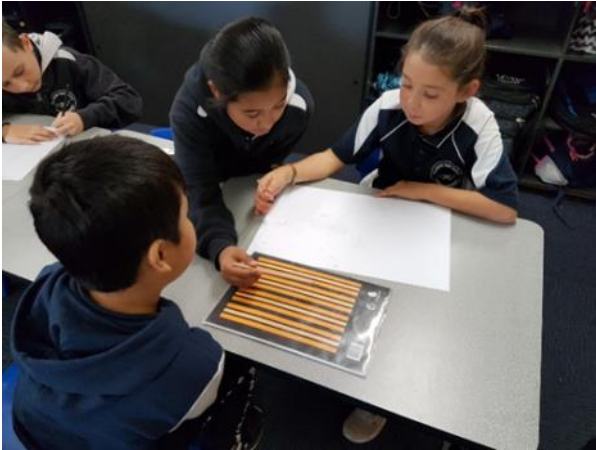

Sibling photos can still be ordered after the online cut off date by collecting an envelope from the office and returning the envelope on photo day with your payment enclosed.

3. The online code above may also be used to order sports and other group photos.

## Road Safety

Several concerned community members have mentioned observing a number of children getting in and out of cars from the middle of the road side. This is an unsafe practice, especially with little children. If you are parking and collecting children, it would be safest to get them into the car from the footpath side. On Thursday 14th, there was a near miss as a child stood on the road with their mother nearby with the car door wide open for quite a while, and another car parked opposite preventing traffic from being able to get past.
