2020 has been a busy year for Health and PE. Across the whole school there has been a focus on well-being in health. The kitchen and health program have supported each other continuing to create healthy meals while students have been taught about healthy eating across all year levels.

In PE students have learnt about a number of sports, including, netball, cricket and badminton. Rooms 4 and 5 are coming to the end of the social sports model which will culminate in a grand final between two of the competing teams.

In 2020 STEM we have followed the same themes as the whole school with our learning. In term one's Kindness theme, our students focussed on kindness to the environment. In term two we learnt about web design, online safety and computer codes and messages. Term three was a very busy term full of learning about entomology and arachnology. This term our older students are learning to be civil engineers while our younger students are learning about materials.
