You can't reply to this number so please contact the school if you'd like to respond.

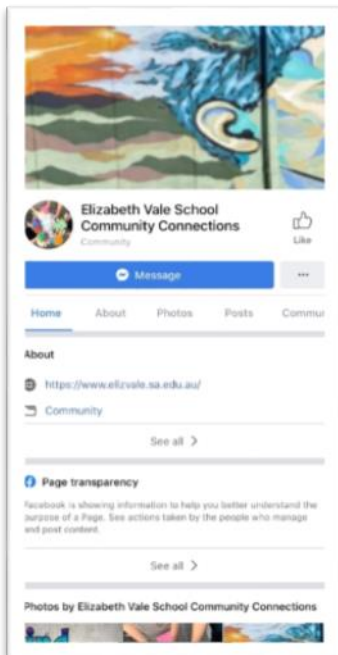

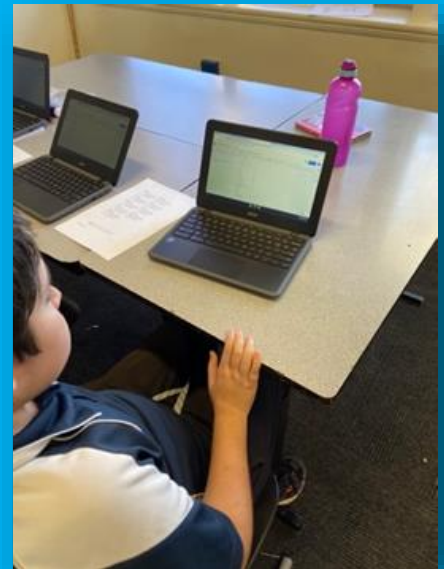
